In furtherance of our previous disclosure dated September 18, 2025, we wish to inform you of further developments in the ongoing litigation against Maharashtra State Electricity Distribution Company Limited (MSEDCL).

#### a. Update on Special Leave Petition (SLP) (61237 of 2024):

The Hon'ble Supreme Court, vide its order dated October 6, 2025, has dismissed the Special Leave Petition filed by MSEDCL challenging the final order dated October 24, 2024, passed by the Appellate Tribunal for Electricity (APTEL) in Appeal Nos. 245 of 2018 and 376 of 2018. A copy of the Supreme Court's order was received on Monday, October 13, 2025, at 20.06 Hrs (IST). Accordingly, the SLP stands disposed of, and the APTEL order has attained finality.
